Notice is given hereby that the Zoning, Planning, and Appeals Commission of the Village of Mettawa will conduct a virtual or electronic public hearing under Case Nos. 20-TA-1 and 20-SU-1 at 7:00 p.m. on August 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020, regarding the application of St. Basil of Ostrog Serbian Orthodox Church (the "Applicant") for a text amendment to Section 15.1106 H. of the Village of Mettawa Zoning Ordinance and for a Special Use for a Place of Public Assembly in the R-1 Residential District upon the Property legally described as follows:

Parcel 1: Lot 1 in Church of the Redeemer Subdivision, being a Resubdivision of Lots 1 and 2 in Rolling Meadows of Mettawa Subdivision, according to the Plat of Resubdivision recorded September 24, 1999 as Document 4425023, in Lake County, Illinois.
